Alcohol and Africa

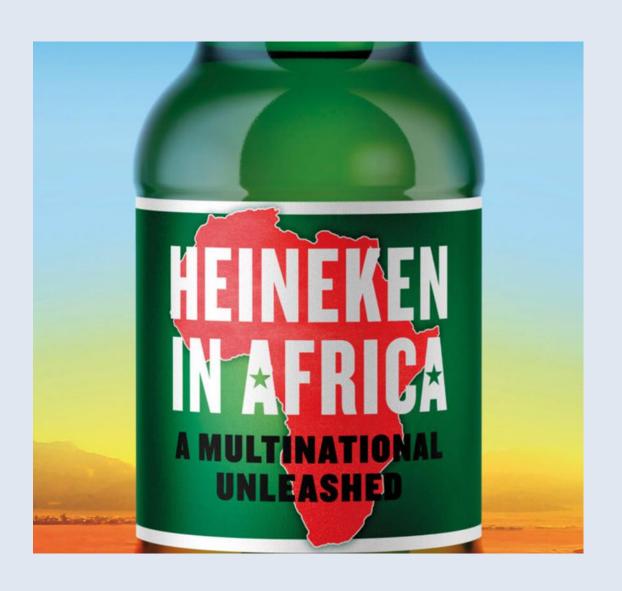
- Lifetime abstainers = 57.5%
- Current drinkers = 32.2%
- Heavy episodic drinkers 15-24 year olds
- Globally highest age-standardized alcohol attributable burden of injury and disease

>Industry profits dependent on heavy drinkers

- UGANDA have adopted SAFER
- Botswana introduced levy
- Reduced since 2018
- Reintroduced alcohol sales into stadiums
